Flying Officer Geoffrey Ernest Charles ARCHER (124410), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, 124410), Royal No. 199 Squadron. No.

No. 199 Squadron. One night in August, 1943, this officer was the pilot of an aircraft detailed to attack Turin. When nearing the Alps on the outward flight, one of the bomber's engines failed. Despite this, Flying Officer Archer continued to the target which he bombed successfully. Shortly afterwards, Flying Officer Archer succeeded in re-starting the defective engine but soon after crossing the Alps on the return flight the engine again failed. Nevertheless Flying Officer Archer succeeded in flying the bomber to base. This officer displayed outstanding skill and determination, setting a commendable example.

Flying Officer Francis Scott BANNER (118153), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 243 Squadron. This officer has taken part in many sorties and has invariably displayed great skill and tenacity. On one occasion, whilst attacking troops and transport the propeller of his aircraft was severely damaged by striking the ground. Despite this, Flying Officer Banner flew the aircraft to base. He has destroyed 4 enemy aircraft; one of them in an engagement against a superior number of fighters.

fighters. Flying Officer Robert Barson COWPER (Aus.407666), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 108 Squadron. This officer has completed 68 sorties and has displayed great courage and determination. During a sortie in January, 1943, Flying Officer Cowper was compelled to make a forced landing behind the enemy's lines but he displayed great resource in outwitting the enemy and regained our own lines on foot. One night in July, 1943, he engaged a Junkers 88 and caused it to explode. The enemy aircraft disintegrated and a large portion struck and so disabled Flying Officer Cowper's aircraft that he was forced to leave it by parachute. He was later rescued from the sea and rejoined his squadron to resume operational and rejoined his squadron to resume operational flying. Since then, Flying Officer Cowper has destroyed another Junkers 88.

Flying Officer Aubrey Howard FERNIHOUGH (134506), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 37 Squadron.

This officer has taken part in 65 sorties, involv-ing operations in North Africa, Pantellaria and Sicily. Sicily. His work in the battle areas has been of the highest order and has been executed with great dash and daring. On one occasion he bombed dash and daring. On one occasion he bombeu the airfield at St. Marie du Zit with unerring skill. In more recent operations, Flying Officer Fernihough has participated in attacks on ports and other targets in Sicily, accomplishing excellent work. By his great skill, thoroughness and gallantry, this officer has set an example worthy of ' In the highest praise.

Pilot Officer Lionel George SEARLE (16036), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 256 Squadron.

This officer has undertaken many sorties at night and, in recent operations over Sicily, has destroyed 3 enemy aircraft, two of them in one sortie. Pilot Officer Searle has displayed exceptional keenness and skill.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

968356 Flight Sergeant Francis Robert WILLIAMS, Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 223 Squadron.

This airman has completed 40 sorties involving attacks on targets ranging from El Alamein to Tunisia and more recently against Pantellaria and Sicily. In July, 1943, during an attack on an airfield in Sicily, Flight Sergeant Williams was wounded in the chest in the course of the bombing run. Although in great pain, he remained at his post and released his bombs with good effect. Flight Sergeant Williams has displayed outstanding keenness and set a courageous example.
