STAFFORDSHIRE POTTERIES WATER BOARD.

SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

Whereas the period limited by section 18 of the Staffordshire Potteries Water Board Act, 1937 (hereinafter called "the local Act") for the compulsory purchase of lands for the purposes of the waterworks authorised by section 6 of the local Act was extended by the Minister of Health (hereinafter called "the Minister") by the Staffordshire Potteries Water (Extension of Time) Order, 1940, to the 1st day of October, 1943;

And whereas section 9 of the local Act provides that the period for the construction of the said waterworks shall be limited to seven years from the passing of that Act that is to say, until the 30th day of July, 1944;

And whereas the Staffordshire Potteries Water Board have made application to the Minister for an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, to extend by three years the periods as now limited for (a) the compulsory purchase of the said lands and (b) the construction of the said waterworks.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister will consider any objections or representations made to him in writing against the grant of the said application before the 27th day of September, 1943, by any person or body interested in the subject-matters of the said application and proposed Order.
