A Dispute happened lately between the Archibishop of Mechlen and the Magistrates of that City, concerning a Person, who having committed murder, took Refuge in a Monastery, from whater the Magistrate could him to be from whence the Magistrates caused him to be taken by force. The Archbishop thereupon excommunicated the principal Officer concerned in this affair, enjoining the Priests to leave off Mass whenever he should come into any Church: The Civil Magistrates on the other hand resenting this Proceeding, seized the Archbishop's Temporal Estate, and have condemned him in a Fine of 10000 Florins, unless he take off the excommunication within a certain time. This matter has been brought before the Council of State here. and is by them referred to the Courts of Madrid and Rome; And in the mean time they have forbid the Magistrates to proceed any farther, and the like Prohibition is made to the Archbishop by the Pope's Nuncio.
