**LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.**

*River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Board  
Kilpin Internal Drainage District.*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, proposes to make an Order confirming a scheme submitted to him by the River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Board, under section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the following matters:—

1. The constitution of a new internal drainage district to be known as the Kilpin Internal Drainage District.

2. The constitution of a Drainage Board for the said Internal Drainage District.

3. Certain matters supplemental to the above provisions.

A copy of the draft Order has been deposited, together with a copy of the Scheme as amended, and of the map on the 6 in. scale which has been substituted for the map referred to in the Scheme, at the Office of W.
