Distinguished Service Order.

Acting Wing Commander David Scott Shearman WILKERSON, D.F.C. (62281), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 578 Squadron. This officer has completed many sorties on his second tour of operations. He has displayed high

second tour of operations. He has displayed high powers of leadership, great skill and determina-tion, qualities which have earned him much success. He is a devoted and zealous squadron commander, whose great drive and tactical ability have contributed in a large measure to the high standard of operational efficiency of the squadron.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flight Lieutenant Alan Frederick FORSDIKE (61953), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 158 Squadron. 158

Squadron. This officer has participated in a large number of attacks on enemy targets, including such centres as Berlin, Hamburg, Essen and Kassel. He is a navigator of high merit, whose example of courage and determination has been inspiring. He has proved his skill in many difficult situa-tions and his efforts have contributed greatly to the successes obtained the successes obtained.

Flight Lieutenant James Norris REYNOLDS (119882), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 158

Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 158 Squadron. This officer has set a fine example of skill, courage and devotion to duty. He has completed a large number of sorties during which he has successfully attacked many dangerous and diffi-cult targets. On one occasion, whilst over Berlin, his aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire. The starboard aileron was badly damaged and the aircraft temporarily went out of control. Flight Lieutenant Reynolds regained control however, and, although much physical effort was required to keep the aircraft on a level course, he pressed home his attack and afterwards flew safely to base. This officer displayed skill, determination and devotion to duty of the highest standard. .cting Flight Lieutenant Thomas NEISON (138890).

Acting Flight Lieutenant Thomas NEISON (138890), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 630

Squadron. In April, 1944, this officer was the mid-upper gunner of an aircraft which attacked an industrial plant at Clermont Ferrand. Soon after crossing the enemy coast, on the return flight, Flight Lieutenant Neison sighted an enemy fighter coming in to the attack. In the ensuing fight, Flight Lieutenant Neison defended his aircraft

with much skill and finally struck the enemy airwith much skill and finally struck the enemy air-craft with a well placed burst of fire causing it to explode in the air. This officer has completed a large number of sorties and has proved himself to be a keen and confident gunner. His deter-mination and fine fighting spirit have set an excellent example.

Flying Officer David Robert COURAGE (Aus.426219), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 158 Squadron. As air gunner, Flying Officer Courage has taken part in a large number of sorties and throughout has displayed a high standard of efficiency and resolution. On one occasion, in an attack on Hamburg, his aircraft was attacked 3 times by fighters. Flying Officer Courage sighted the enemy aircraft on each occasion and his prompt and skilful directions to his pilot played a good part in frustrating the attackers. He has at all times displayed great keenness and devotion to duty. to duty.

Flying Officer John Andrew Cameron KENNEDY (Aus.409001), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 467 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

As air bomber, this officer has taken part in very many sorties against targets in Germany and throughout has displayed unfailing devotion to duty and praiseworthy skill. One night in April, 1944, Flying Officer Kennedy took part in an attack on Munich. Whilst over the target he was attack on Munich. Whilst over the target he was struck by a fragment of shrapnel and sustained a broken rib and severe bruising. In spite of the pain and discomfort, Flying Officer Kennedy con-tinued to direct the aircraft on its bombing run and successfully attacked the target. Thereafter, he remained at his post until this country was reached. His exemplary conduct was most com-mendable mendable.

Flying Officer Wilfred Arthur LENNARD (124735), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 158 Squadron.

Squadron. In the course of his operational tour this officer has taken part in attacks on a wide range of strongly defended targets in Germany. His navi-gational ability has been of a high standard throughout and has played a good part in the successes obtained. On one occasion in February 1944, he was the navigator of an aircraft de-tailed to attack Leipzig. Shortly after crossing the enemy coast the air speed indicator failed. In spite of this, the captain decided to continue the mission. In the face of difficulties, accen-tuated by heavy cloud, Flying Officer Lennard skilfully guided his captain to the target which was successfully attacked. His ability and resource contributed in a large measure to the success of a most trying sortie.

Flying Officer Dudley Francis WARD (Aus.420413), Royal Australian Air Force No. 463 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

This officer has completed numerous sorties and has set a fine example of skill and determination. One night in April, 1944, he piloted an aircraft detailed for a bombing mission. Soon after his attack had been successfully completed one engine of his aircraft failed. Shortly afterwards, two more failed and the bomber began to lose height. The flight engineer succeeded in re-starting one of the defective engines however and the enemy coast was crossed at a low altitude. Eventually, an airfield was reached and Flying Officer Ward effected a safe landing. This officer displayed exceptional skill and determination throughout and This officer has completed numerous sorties and exceptional skill and determination throughout and his achievement was worthy of the greatest praise.

Pilot Officer Stanley DALE (169884), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 158 Squadron. This officer has participated in a large number of successful sorties. He has displayed a high degree of skill and resolution and, on more than one occasion, his navigational ability has con-tributed materially to the safe return of his air-craft. He has at all times displayed keepness and craft. He has at all times displayed keenness and devotion to duty, setting a praiseworthy example.

Pilot Officer Robert Cecil HOOPER (172176), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 630 Squadron One night in April, 1944, this officer was the pilot of an aircraft detailed to attack Munich.

pilot of an aircraft detailed to attack Munich. On the outward flight the aircraft was engaged by fighters. Early in the fight the mid-upper and rear turrets were put out of action and the rear gunner was badly wounded. Pilot Officer Hooper manœuvred his defenceless aircraft with great skill however, and eventually the attackers broke off the engagement. The bomber had sus-tained much damage but this did not deter Pilot Officer Hooper from continuing his mission. The target was far distant but he went on to execute a successful attack and afterwards flew the dama successful attack and afterwards flew the dam-aged bomber to base. This officer set a fine example of skill; courage and resolution.

Pilot Officer Ronald James SCAMMELL (173784), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 218 Squadron.

One night in May, 1944, this officer piloted an aircraft which attacked a target in German occu-pied territory. Soon after the bombs had been aircraft which attacked a target in German occu-pied territory. Soon after the bombs had been released the aircraft was attacked by twoofighters. The first one was evaded but machine gun and cannon fire from the second fighter struck the bomber and caused much damage. The flight engineer was killed and the gunners were wounded. The aircraft became very difficult to control and most of the instruments had been rendered useless, nevertheless, Pilot Officer Scammell flew the aircraft to base where, with the flaps and the undercarriage inoperative, he made a successful crash-landing. In most difficult circumstances, this officer displayed a high degree of skill, courage and determination.

degree of skin, courage and determination. Pilot Officer James WISBEY (172872), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 640 Squadron. This officer has completed very many sorties, including 4 attacks on Berlin and 3 on Frank-furt. He has set a fine example of devotion to duty and has invariably pressed home his attacks with event determination. duty and has invariably pressed home his attacks with great determination. One night in March, 1944, he piloted an aircraft detailed to attack Stuttgart. Soon after leaving base, it was dis-covered that the overload tank was not function-ing. Nevertheless, Pilot Officer Wisbey flew on to his far distant target and made his attack. He afterwards flew safely back to this country and landed at an airfield with only sufficient petrol left for a few minutes flying. His determination was typical of that he has always shown to com-plete his allotted task successfully.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Pilot Officer Leonard HUNT (172474), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 166 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

Sergeant Montague William SAUNDERS, Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 166 1874602 Sera Royal Air 166 Squadron.

One night in April, 1944, this officer and air-man were pilot and flight engineer respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack Friedrichshafen. When approaching the target the aircraft was struck by bursts of machine-gun fire from a fighter.

The rear turret was shattered and its occupant was fatally hit; the mid-upper turret was put out of action and the gunner was wounded. A large hole was torn in the elevator and the fuselage. The bomb doors were damaged, causing a failure of the hydraulic gear, whilst the mainplane itself was riddled by flying splinters. The bomber dived steeply but Pilot Officer Hunt, aided by Sergeant Saunders succeeded in regaining control. Despite steeply but Pilot Officer Hunt, aided by Sergeant Saunders succeeded in regaining control. Despite the havoc caused by the attacker, Pilot Officer Hunt was determined to deliver his bombs. As the run-in was begun, Sergeant Saunders was hit in the leg and thigh by fragments of shrapnel from a shell which burst near the aircraft. Despite this he refrained from informing his pilot how-ever, and the bombing run was completed with success. By this time, the aircraft was in a perilous position, being so nose heavy that it was beyond the strength of the pilot to keep the air-craft steady. Two members of the crew came to his assistance and finally they fixed a wire from craft steady. Two members of the crew came to his assistance and finally they fixed a wire from the mid-upper turret to the control column and were able to pull when directed by their pilot. Thus assisted, Pilot Officer Hunt eventually reached this country where he effected a safe land-ing although as the aircraft touched down the undercarriage collapsed. This officer displayed the finest qualities of skill, courage and tenacity in the face of almost impossible odds. Sergeant finest qualities of skill, courage and tenacity in the face of almost impossible odds. Sergeant Saunders also proved himself to be a brave and devoted member of aircraft crew. Although suffering acutely from his injuries he executed his engineering tasks with great skill, a factor which proved of the greatest assistance throughout the long and trying flight home.
