**C**ount d'Aversberg, the Emperor's late Ambassador at the Court of Spain, having been obliged to retire from thence; the like Intimation has, by his Imperial Majesty's Order, been sent to the Duke of Moles, the Spanish Ambassador here, and he is accordingly preparing for his departure, and intends to go to *Nusdorf*, a Village about a league distant from hence, where he has Leave to continue for some days. The Elector Palatine's Minister having represented to the Emperor, how much his Matter's Territories lie exposed to the Forces which the French have lately brought into the Spanish *Guelderland*, his Imperial Majesty has resolved, that the Forces which the King of Prussia and the Princes of the House of *Lunenburgh* are to put into his Service, shall march to the *Lower Rhine*, in order to form a Camp with other Troops of the Empire on that side, while the Emperor's main Army acts on the *Upper Rhine* under the Command of Prince *Lewis of Baden*. The Elector of *Bavaria's* Resident has made Complaint, of some Disorders committed by two Imperial Regiments which lately passed through the Electorate of *Bavaria* in their March to the *Upper Rhine*, and the Emperor's Ministers have given Directions for enquiring into the Fact. to the end Satisfaction may be given to the Persons injured. The Regiments of *Mansfeld* and *Guido Staremberg* are to be Reviewed to morrow by their Colonels, the one at *Presburgh*, and the other at *Ciaketurn* in *Stiria*. and the next day they will begin their March towards *Italy*; The rest of the Imperial Forces designed thither are in motion, and the foremost of them are said to be arrived near *Trent*. Prince *Philip of Lichtenstein* went from hence yesterday towards *Esseck*, to take Possession of the Government of that Town, and the District thereunto belonging, which was lately given him upon Count *Guido of Starzenberg's* resigning the same.

*Francfort, April 6.* The Elector of *Bavaria* arrived the 4th Instant at *Wurtzburgh*, where he was splendidly entertained by the Bishop of that Place, and his Electoral Highness is expected this day at *Munich*. They write from *Strasbourg*, that the Regiment of *Normandy*, and another French Regiment, with several Troops of *Cuirassiers*, are marched from thence

to *Landau*. Letters from *Switzerland* say, the Republick of *Venice* is treating with the Cantons of *Zurich* and *Bern* for 3000 Men of their Troops, and that Proposals have been made to the *Swiss Cantons* for an Alliance between them, the Republick of *Venice*, and the *Grisons*; The latter have resolved to raise their Militia for the better Security of their Frontiers, and have refused the Assistance which has been offered them by the *French*.

*Hamburg, April 8.* Letters from *Copenhagen* give an Account, that the King of *Denmark* has agreed to assist the Emperor and his Allies with 16000 Men, including the 7500 *Danish* Forces which are now in *Saxony*, and which are to be put into the Emperor's Service. The Advices from *Sweden* speak of the great Preparations that are making there to send over Forces to *Livonia*, where the King of *Sweden* intends to be early in the Field this Summer. They write from *Warsaw*, that the General Diet of *Poland* is appointed to meet there the 30th of *May*, and that the Accommodating of the Differences between the House of *Sapieha* and the Nobility of *Lithuania*, as also the examining of the Demands of the Deputies, lately sent to the King of *Poland* by the Nobility of the *Greater Poland*, is referred to this Assembly.

*Hague, April 12.* Engineer-General *Cochorn* has given an Account to the States-General, of the Condition of the Fortifications of *Bergenopzoom*, and other Frontier Places, which he has lately visited; and having likewise had several Conferences with the Deputies of the States, and the Count de *Nassaw Weylbourg*, and other General Officers, is returned to *Bergenopzoom*. The Council of State is in Treaty with several Persons, who propose to furnish Horses for the Train of Artillery. Commissions are daily given out to the Officers who are to serve in the new-raised Regiments, which will be compleat by the beginning of the next Month. Count *Goes*, the Emperor's Envoy, was yesterday in Conference with the Deputies of the States. The States of *Holland* and *Westfriseland* are adjourned till this day sevenight. They write from *Cologne*, that Publick Notice has been given throughout that Archbishoprick, that all the Inhabitants do forthwith send their best Effects to Places of Safety.
