

The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby announce that They have made an Order under Section 20 of the Finance (No. 2) Act, 1940, entitled the Purchase Tax (Alteration of Rates) (No. 2) Order, 1945, directing that as from the 31st March, 1945, purchase tax shall become chargeable at the rate of 16½ per cent. instead of 33½ per cent. in respect of aluminium hollow-ware of a kind used for domestic purposes.

Traders are reminded that these goods remain liable to tax at the rate of 33½ per cent. until the Order becomes operative and they will be accountable for tax accordingly.
