ROYAL WARRANT.

GEORGE THE SIXTH, by the Grace of God, of
Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions
beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith,
Emperor of India, to all to whom these Presents
shall come:

Greeting:

Whereas Her late Majesty Queen Victoria did by
Warrant under Her Royal Sign Manual, bearing
date the tenth day of April, One thousand nine
hundred, in the sixty-third year of Her Reign, insti-
tute and create a decoration to be styled "Kaisar-i-
Hind Medal for Public Service in India," and did
make certain Rules and Ordinances for the govern-
ment of the same:And whereas by the said Royal Warrant power
was reserved to Us of annulling and altering the
said Rules and Ordinances or any part thereof by
a Notification under Our Royal Sign Manual:And whereas alterations and amendments in the
said Rules and Ordinances were made by His late
Majesty King Edward the Seventh by Warrant under
His Royal Sign Manual bearing date the eighth day
of July, One thousand nine hundred and one and
by His late Majesty King George the Fifth by
Warrants under His Royal Sign Manual bearing
date the ninth day of July, One thousand nine
hundred and twelve and the second day of
November, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-
three, and by Us under Our Royal Sign Manual
bearing date the twenty-fourth day of June, One
thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, and the
twenty-first day of December, One thousand nine
hundred and thirty-nine:And whereas We desire to make certain further
alterations to the said Rules and Ordinances:Now know ye that We do by these Presents for
Us, Our Heirs and Successors, make the following
alteration in the said Rules and Ordinances, that
is to say:—At the end of Clause Eighthly the following
shall be added:"And for every Bar awarded, a Rose Emblem
in silver gilt, silver or bronze, as the case may
be, shall be added to the ribbon when worn
alone.Given at Our Court of St. James's, the tenth
day of March One thousand nine hundred
and forty-five, in the Eighth year of Our
