The Regiment of Dragoons commanded by Prince Eugene of Savoy, confifting in 12 Troops of 75 Men in each, was reviewed yesterday in the presence of the Emperor and Empress, the King and Queen of the Romans, and the Arch-Duke and Arch-Dutcheffes, who were received by Prince Engene at the Head of the Regiment, which afterwards continued their march to Italy. Francfort, May 4. The Diet of the Circle of Smabia affembled at Ulm is broke up, having refolved to keep on foot a good Body of Forces, and to make all other Provision for their Security. Count Lowenstein the Emperor's Envoy, passes by the Place yesterday going from Ulm to Duffelderp; and Count Schlick is gone from hence with a Committion from the Emperor to the Elector of Bavaria. The Garrilon of this Place was reinforced this week by two Companies of Foot of the Bishop of Wartzburgh's Forces. They write from diffuse, that the French continue their Preparations in those Parts, and talk of making a Bridge of Boats over the Rime near Fort Louis.
