

WANTAGE URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL.

Notice of alteration of declared calorific value.

NOTICE is hereby given, pursuant to the Gas Undertakings (Alteration of Declared Calorific Value) Order, 1943 (S.R. & O. No. 1720) dated 14th December, 1943, made by the Minister of Fuel and Power under Regulation 56 of the Defence (General) Regulations 1939, that the Wantage Urban District Council intend altering the declared Calorific Value of the gas supplied by them within the limits of supply of the Council, hereinafter described, and that the Calorific Value of the gas which the Council intend to supply is 460 British Thermal Units per Cubic Foot instead of 500 British Thermal Units per Cubic Foot, and further that the date from which the Council will supply gas of the said Calorific Value will be the 14th day of July, 1945.

The limits of supply of the Council include the urban district of Wantage and the parishes of East Challow, Grove and Letcombe Regis in the rural district of Wantage in the county of Berks.
