

Franconia are ordered to draw together on the *Rhine*, to join the Imperial Army commanded by Prince *Lewis* of *Baden*. The Diet of the Circle of the *Upper Rhine* have resolved to augment their Troops. The Duke Regent of *Wirtemberg* is gone to *Nuremberg*, to confer with Prince *Lewis* of *Baden*.

Cologne, June 24. Our Garrison was reinforced two days ago by 5 Companies of the Bishop of *Munster's* Forces, and General *Thungen* is appointed to command here, in case there is any danger of our being attacked by the *French*. The Elector *Palatine* has given Orders for levelling the Ground about the Town of *Tuliers*, and for demolishing all the Buildings near that Place which might be of use to an Enemy in case of a Siege. About 6000 Men of the Forces of *Lunenburg* and *Hesse-Cassel* are come to *Santen*, not far from *Wesel*, and will shortly be joined by the Forces of the King of *Prussia* and other Princes, in order to form a Camp in those Parts.

Hamburg, June 24. The Duke of *Holslein* *Gottorp* went from hence yesterday to *Kiel*. Letters from *Livonia* give an Account, that several *Swedish* Regiments were arrived at *Reval* from *Stockholm*, *Careishawen*, and other Places, to the number of 2000 Horse and 10000 Foot; that 6000 Men more were expected from *Sweden*, and that as soon as these Forces are got together, the King of *Sweden* will march towards *Pleskow*. They write from *Warsaw*, that the General Diet assembled there has desired the King of *Poland* to make a Peace with *Sweden*, and to send home his *Saxon* Forces: and that an Answer was returned, That the King is very willing to comply with the Desires of the Diet, and that the said Forces should march home in a short time, provided the Places which they have possessed themselves of in *Livonia* may be garrisoned by the Forces of the Republick.

Brussels, June 28. About 800 Wagons are come from the *French* Conquests to *Geiderland* laden with Ammunition, &c. and the *French* are providing great Trains of Artillery at *Louvain*, *Chentz*, and *Antwerp*. 'Tis said, that *Montieur de Bagnols* has received a Commission from *Spain*, to be Intendant-General of Justice and the Finances in these Provinces. 'Tis said likewise, that Orders are sent to several of the Principa Nobility of this Country, to raise Troops at their own Charge for the Service of the King of *Spain*. The Count *de Bergeick* is expecting a Commission from *Spain*, to be Comptroller-General of the Revenues of these Countries. A farther Order is expected, to stop the Payment of all Pensions, which occasions a great Dissatisfaction among those that are concerned. *Don Quiros* is come hither from *Aix la Chapelle*, and will shortly return to the *Hague*.

Hague, June 28. The Count of *Nissaw* *Saxenbruck* is made Colonel of the *Dutch* Foot-Guards, and Engineer-General *Cookhorn* Governor of *Slaice*, in the room of the late Duke of *Wirtemberg*; but the Commission of General of the *Dutch* Infantry is not yet disposed of. The Earl of *Albemarle* arrived here two days ago from *England*, and he intends in 3 or 4 days to go to *Geiderland*. A Line is making to cover *Breda*, *Hensler*, *Gerruydenberg*, and our other Frontier Garrisons on that side.

Paris, June 29. N. S. The Court is still at *Marly*, where an Express is arrived from the Marshal *de Castinat*, with Letters of the 28th Instant, which 'tis said give an Account, that the *German*s are encamped in the Island formed by the *Adige* near *Rovigo*, not having yet passed the little Branch of that River called the *Adigetto*. Letters from *Turin* of the 18th Instant say, the Duke of *Savoy* intended to set out in 2 or 3 days for *Milan*, and that 6000 Men of his Forces were already marched thither. 'Tis said, the King of *Spain* will appoint the Marquis *de Cassil Rodrigo*, a Grandee, to go with the Character of his Ambassador to the Duke of *Savoy*, to demand in Marriage the Princess his Daughter, and that a Procuracy will be sent to the Prince of *Carignan* to marry her in his Catholic Majesty's Name. The Abbot of *Soubise* was consecrated last Sunday Bishop Coadjutor of *Strasburgh*, which Ceremony was performed in the Abbey of *St. Germans* by the Cardinal of *Furstenberg*. Count *Briord*, who was Ambassador at the *Hague*, is made one of the King's Counsellors of State.
