

Applications from intending candidates who do not satisfy the educational requirement but who contemplate sitting for a School Certificate or Matriculation examination will be considered up to 1st November, 1946, provided the candidates have then obtained the required qualifications.

(4) Executive Class, (5) Officer of Customs and Excise.

Applications from intending candidates who do not satisfy the educational requirement but who contemplate sitting for a Higher Certificate or University Intermediate examination will be considered up to 1st January, 1947 (or, in the case of Service candidates, 18 months after completion of their service or 31st December, 1948, whichever is the earlier), provided the candidates have then obtained the required qualifications. Further extension beyond 31st December, 1948, for service candidates may be considered in individual cases.
