TREASURY NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 5 (4) OF THE DEFENCE (FINANCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that as from the 21st November, 1945, the following foreign currencies are designated by the Treasury under Regulation 5 (4) of the Defence (Finance) Regulations, 1939, as foreign currencies to which the said Regulation applies:—
