**TREASURY NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 5 (4) OF THE DEFENCE (FINANCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.**

The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that as from the 21st November, 1945, the following foreign currencies are designated by the Treasury under Regulation 5 (4) of the Defence (Finance) Regulations, 1939, as foreign currencies to which the said Regulation applies:—
