WATER ACT, 1945.

BUCKS WATER BOARD.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Bucks Water Board (hereinafter called "the Board") are about to make application to the Minister of Health for an Order under section 23 of the above mentioned Act (proposed to be called "the Bucks Water Board (Works) (No. 2) Order, 1946"), to authorise the Board to construct certain waterworks in the county of Buckingham, including a pumping station in the parish of Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards (Amersham Rural District) and a service reservoir in the parish of Wendover (Aylesbury Rural District).
