ADMINISTRATIVE COUNTY OF LONDON.

THE London County Council is applying to the Ministry of Transport for an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940 (a) to extend by three years from the present expiring date the time, limited by the London County Council (General Powers) Act, 1939, for works at Millbank and for the South Bank improvement; and (b) to extend by a further three years the time now limited by the London County Council (Extension of Time) Order, 1943; (i) for works at Cable Street, Stepney, authorised by the London County Council (Tramways and Improvements) Act, 1920; (ii) for the compulsory purchase of lands authorised by the London County Council (General Powers) Act, 1925, in connection with the widening of the Strand, Westminster; (iii) for the compulsory purchase of lands and for works in connection with a new street from Garford Street, Poplar, to West India Dock Road, Stepney, authorised by the London County Council (General Powers) Act, 1934; (iv) for the compulsory purchase of lands and for works in connection with the Cromwell Road extension authorised by the London and Middlesex (Improvements, etc.) Act, 1936; (v) for the compulsory purchase of lands required for the southern approach to Wandsworth Bridge and the duplication of Blackwall Tunnel authorised by the London County Council (Tunnel and Improvements) Act, 1938.
