SUMMARY.

The foregoing list contains 252 cases viz:—13 American, 21 Austrian, 3 Belgian, 12 Czecho-Slovak, 7 Dutch, 4 French, 121 German, 2 Greek, 7 Hungarian, 19 Italian, 1 Lithuanian, 7 No Nationality, 7 Polish 1 Portuguese, 5 Roumanian, 9 Russian, 1 Swiss and 12 other Nationalities.

Of these, 61 (including 3 American, 1 Austrian, 2 Belgian, 1 Chinese, 1 Czecho-Slovak, 3 Dutch, 2 Egyptian, 1 Finnish, 1 French, 26 German, 1 Greek, 8 Italian, 3 Polish, 1 Portuguese, 2 Roumanian, 3 Russian, 2 Spanish) relate to women of British origin.
