THE PARISHES OF MUNDON AND LATCHINGDON.

Alteration of Local Boundaries consequent upon alteration of watercourse.

Whereas the Essex Rivers Catchment Board have carried out alterations in certain portions of the channel of the Latchingdon Brook (hereinafter referred to as "the watercourse") which forms part of the boundary line between the parishes of Mundon and Latchingdon;

And whereas the said Catchment Board have, in accordance with sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, notified the Minister of Health of the above mentioned alterations, and the Minister is satisfied that a new boundary line may conveniently be adopted:

Now therefore the Minister of Health, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, hereby declares that the watercourse shown outlined red on the map deposited at the offices of the Ministry of Health, Whitehall, S.W.1 (which map is sealed with the seal of the Minister, and marked "Map referred to in the Notice published in August, 1946, in the 'London Gazette' under sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, relating to the alteration of a watercourse in the County of Essex") shall as from the date of this Notice be substituted for the watercourse shown coloured blue on the said map as part of the boundary line between the said parishes.

And notice is hereby given that, consequent upon the foregoing declaration whereby the limits of areas of local government, of which the watercourse shown coloured blue on the deposited map formed part of the boundary, are deemed to have been varied in accordance with the Declaration, the area shown coloured yellow between the watercourse shown coloured blue and the watercourse shown outlined red on the deposited map is, by virtue of sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, situate in the Parish of Mundon, and the area shown coloured green between the watercourse shown coloured blue and the watercourse shown outlined red on the deposited map is, by virtue of sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, situate in the Parish of Latchingdon.

And notice is hereby further given that the map deposited at the offices of the Ministry of Health, Whitehall, S.W.1, and copies thereof which have been lodged at the offices of the Essex County Council, County Hall, Chelmsford, Essex, are open to inspection without payment during ordinary office hours.

THE PARISHES OF ABOVE DERWENT AND UNDERSKIDDAW.

Alteration of Local Boundaries consequent upon alteration of Watercourse.

Whereas the West Cumberland Rivers Catchment Board, having taken over the rights, powers and duties of the River Derwent Catchment Board, have carried out alterations in certain portions of the channel of the River Derwent (hereinafter referred to as "the watercourse") which forms part of the boundary line between the parishes of Above Derwent and Underskiddaw;

And whereas the said Catchment Board have, in accordance with sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, notified the Minister of Health of the above mentioned alterations, and the Minister is satisfied that a new boundary line may conveniently be adopted:

Now therefore the Minister of Health, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, hereby declares that the watercourse shown outlined red on the map deposited at the offices of the Ministry of Health, Whitehall, S.W.1 (which map is sealed with the seal of the Minister, and is marked "Map referred to in the Notice published in August, 1946, in the 'London Gazette' under sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, relating to the alteration of a watercourse in the county of Cumberland") shall as from the date of this Notice be substituted for the watercourse shown coloured blue on the said map as part of the boundary line between the said parishes.

And notice is hereby given that, consequent upon the foregoing Declaration whereby the limits of areas of local government, of which the watercourse shown coloured blue on the deposited map formed part of the boundary, are deemed to have been varied in accordance with the Declaration, the area shown coloured green between the watercourse shown coloured blue and the watercourse shown outlined red on the deposited map is, by virtue of sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, situate in the Parish of Above Derwent, and the area shown coloured yellow on the watercourse shown outlined red on the deposited map is, by virtue of sub-section (1) of section 145 of the Local Government Act, 1933, situate in the Parish of Underskiddaw.

And notice is hereby further given that the map deposited at the offices of the Ministry of Health, Whitehall, S.W.1, and copies thereof which have been lodged at the offices of the Cumberland County Council, County Offices, Carlisle, Cumberland, are open to inspection without payment during ordinary office hours.
