ST. HELENS GAS.

APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL ORDER UNDER THE GAS UNDERTAKINGS ACTS, 1920 TO 1934.

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made by the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the borough of St. Helens (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") whose address is The Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, St. Helens, for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") under and in pursuance of the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934 for all or some of the following, amongst other purposes (that is to say)—

1. To authorise the Corporation for the purposes of facilitating supplies of gas within their limits of supply or of giving a supply of gas in bulk to any local authority company or persons to lay down maintain remove and renew a gas main or pipe in the Liverpool-East Lancashire Road in the urban district of Ashton in Makerfield.
