SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

TORQUAY CORPORATION ACT, 1937.

THE Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Torquay (hereinafter called "the Corporation") are applying to the Minister of Transport for an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, extending for a further period of three years the time limited by Section 24 of the Torquay Corporation Act, 1937 (as extended by Section 1 of the Torquay Corporation (Extension of Time) Order, 1944), in respect of

the exercise of the powers conferred upon the Corporation by Sections 21 and 33 in Part IV (Harbour) and Part V (Sea Front Improvement) of the said Act of 1937 to make the Works therein described (namely):—

Work No. 2.—An extension of Haldon Pier from the cant or elbow thereof for a distance of two hundred and thirty-five feet or thereabouts in a westerly direction;

Work No. 2A.—A pier commencing at or near the termination of Work No. 2 extending in a north-easterly direction for a distance of one hundred and forty feet or thereabouts and terminating at the seaward end of the existing Haldon Pier;

Work No. 3.—A wall on the bed of the Outer Harbour commencing at a point on the east side of Princess Pier fifty-seven yards or thereabouts measured in a southerly direction along the said Pier from the north-west corner of the Outer Harbour and terminating at a point on the west side of the North Quay eleven yards or thereabouts measured in a northerly direction from the seaward extremity of the said Quay;

Work No. 4.—A widening (by means of decking supported by piles in openwork construction) of the footpath along the northern end of the Inner Harbour between Vaughan Parade and Victoria Parade.

Any representation against the grant of this Application must be submitted to the Corporation not later than the 22nd day of November, 1946.
