##### BAKING WAGES COUNCIL (ENGLAND AND WALES).

The Baking Wages Council (England and Wales) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour and National Service proposals for the amendment of the Baking Wages Council (England and Wales) Wages Regulation Order, 1946, dated 9th April, 1946, and for the fixing of specified statutory minimum remuneration in substitution for the minimum rates of wages at present in operation.

The Wages Council will consider any written representations with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within twenty-one days from 15th November, 1946.
