CITY OF GLOUCESTER.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Gloucester (hereinafter called "the Corporation") have made application to the Minister of Health (hereinafter called "the Minister") for the issue of a Provisional Order under section 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partly to repeal, alter or amend the Act (hereinafter called "the local Act") passed on the 6th April, 1821, for the establishment of markets and fairs for the sale of livestock in the City as amended and extended by certain other local Acts, namely, the City of Gloucester Extension and Improvement Act, 1874, and the Gloucester Corporation Acts, 1894, 1911 and 1928, so as:—

(1) to empower the Corporation to alter, from time to time, the places at which their markets and fairs are held, to establish and hold new markets and to discontinue the whole or any part of any existing or new market;

(2) to empower the Corporation to erect or provide market places, market houses, market stands and other such buildings, offices, banks, shops, catering establishments, stores, warehouses, approaches, appliances and conveniences in connection with their markets;

(3) to replace the Schedules of maximum market tolls and charges prescribed by the Gloucester Corporation Acts, 1894, 1911 and 1928, respectively, by a Schedule which will prescribe different maximum tolls and charges;

(4) to empower the Corporation to prohibit any person not in possession of a licence granted by them in pursuance of section 72 of the Gloucester Corporation Act, 1894, from carrying on the business or calling of a porter, drover or carrier in any of the markets of the Corporation or the immediate approaches thereto or highways thereto adjoining;

(5) to authorise the Corporation to borrow with the consent of the Minister such sums as may be necessary for the purposes of the Order;

(6) for the several purposes of the application, or for purposes connected with, incidental to or consequent on those purposes, to make any such alteration or amendment of the local Act, or of any other local Act, or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the City, as may be necessary or desirable;

Notice is hereby given that Colonel G. Ewart Rhodes, M.I.C.E., Barrister at Law, having been duly appointed by the Minister, will attend at the Guildhall, Gloucester on Friday, the 6th day of December, 1946, at half past ten o'clock in the forenoon to hold a local inquiry into the subject-matter of the said application:

COUNTY BOROUGH OF TYNEMOUTH.

SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT,  
1940.

Whereas the period limited by section 51 of the Tynemouth Corporation Act, 1934 (hereinafter called "the local Act") for the compulsory purchase of lands authorised by the local Act and required for the purposes of (a) waterworks and water supply; (b) street improvement and (c) the purposes connected therewith mentioned in section 49 of the local Act was further extended by the Minister of Health (hereinafter called "the Minister") with the concurrence of the Minister of Transport, by the County Borough of Tynemouth (Extension of Time) Order, 1943, by three years, that is to say until the 31st December, 1946;

And whereas the period limited by section 9 of the local Act for the power to construct waterworks was extended by the Minister, by the Tynemouth (Extension of Time) Order, 1943, by three years, that is to say until the 25th July, 1947;

And whereas the County Borough of Tynemouth have made application to the Minister for an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, to extend by a further period of three years, the time as now limited, for (i) the compulsory purchase of lands, and (ii) the construction of the waterworks mentioned above.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister will, in association with the Minister of Transport, consider any objection or representation made to him in writing before the sixteenth day of December, 1946, by any person or body interested in the said application.
