

WATER ACT, 1945:

GRIMSBY CLEETHORPES AND DISTRICT WATER BOARD.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Grimsby Cleethorpes and District Water Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") are about to make application to the Minister of Health for an order under section 10 of the Water Act 1945 to extend the limits of supply of the Board so as to include certain additional parishes in the rural district of Grimsby in the county of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey. The counties and districts comprised wholly or partly in the area affected by the order are the county of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey, the county borough of Grimsby, the borough of Cleethorpes and the rural district of Grimsby.
