## GAS UNDERTAKING.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934.)

Any such objections shall state:—

(a) The specific grounds of objection, and

(b) The omissions, additions or modifications asked for.

A copy of the objection must at the same time be forwarded to the Council.

Copies of the draft Special Order have been deposited for public inspection at the offices of the Clerk of the Council, at the Town Hall, Poulton-le-Fylde.
