

RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS, 1930 TO 1947.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 30 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and section 6 of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, to make regulations further to amend the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations, 1937, by providing for the payment of fees in respect of driving tests to be made to the Clerk to the Traffic Commissioners for the Traffic Area concerned instead of to the person conducting the test when the tests are conducted by Examiners appointed by the Minister; for the reimposition of the conditions attaching to the grant of a provisional licence in the case of all such licences issued after the commencement of the Road Traffic (Driving Licences) Act, 1947; and for the amendment of the form of application for a licence to give effect to the provisions of the Road Traffic (Driving Licences) Act, 1947, and to assist in the administration of the Road Traffic Acts, 1930 to 1934.

And notice is hereby further given that, on account of urgency, the Minister of Transport, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, has made provisional regulations entitled the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Provisional Regulations, 1947, to come into operation forthwith as provisional regulations and to continue

in force until regulations have been made in accordance with section 1 of that Act.
