

6. Examination

The subjects of examination and the marks they will carry are as follows:—

1. English	300
2. Reading Manuscript	100
3. Arithmetic	200
4. Geography	200

Candidates will be arranged in order of merit on their aggregate of marks in the examination as a whole. Even if there are unfilled vacancies, no candidate will be appointed who does not obtain such an aggregate as to satisfy the Civil Service Commissioners.

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 42 of 1947.

Subject.

1. Revokes Orders Nos. 6808, 6812, 6819 and 6822.
2. Declares an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Ashford, Middlesex; Bracknell and Maidenhead, Berks; and Ewell, Epsom, Surrey, to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spreading of foot-and-mouth disease, to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The area subject to restrictions lies in the counties of Berks., Bucks., Middlesex and Surrey.

3. Contracts, as from 15th March, 1947, such Infected Area to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Ewell, Epsom, Surrey.
