METROPOLITAN WATER BOARD.

SPECIAL ENACTMENT (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

Whereas the Metropolitan Water Board (hereinafter called "the Board") are the successors in title of the company of proprietors of the East London Waterworks;

And whereas the Board have made application to the Minister of Health (hereinafter called "the Minister") for an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940 (hereinafter called "the Act of 1940") to extend by a further period the time limited by:—

(1) section 13 of the East London Waterworks Act, 1900, as amended by subsection (2) of section 57 of the Metropolitan Water Board Act, 1913, section 6 of the Metropolitan Water Board Act, 1927, and paragraph (b) of section 39 of the Metropolitan Water Board Act, 1935, for the construction of conduit No. 3 being work (8) authorised by section 4 of the said Act of 1900, and

(2) section 13 of the East London Waterworks Act, 1900, as amended by section 3 of the Metropolitan Water Board Act, 1906, subsection (1) of section 57 of the Metropolitan Water Board Act, 1913, subsection (1) of section 5 of the Metropolitan Water Board Act, 1927, and paragraph (a) of section 39 of the Metropolitan Water Board Act, 1935, for the construction of Reservoir No. (2) being Work (2) authorised by section 4 of the said Act of 1900;

And whereas the Minister by the Metropolitan Water Board (Extension of Time) Order, 1943, extended the said periods by three years that is to say to the 1st October, 1948;

And whereas the Board have made application to the Minister for an Order under the Act of 1940 to extend the periods as now limited until the 30th June, 1950;
