GRIMSBY, CLEETHORPES AND DISTRICT
WATER BOARD.

SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME)
ACT, 1940.

Whereas the Grimsby, Cleethorpes and District
Water Board (hereinafter called "the Board") made
application to the Minister of Health (hereinafter
called "the Minister") for the issue of an Order
thorpes and District Water (Extension of Time)
