#### WAGES COUNCILS ACT, 1945.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE AN ORDER ESTABLISHING A WAGES COUNCIL IN RESPECT OF WORKERS EMPLOYED IN THE RETAIL BOOKSELLING AND STATIONERY TRADES IN GREAT BRITAIN AND THEIR EMPLOYERS.

The Minister of Labour and National Service having amended the Wages Council (Retail Bookselling and Stationery Trades, England and Wales) Draft Order hereby gives notice in accordance with Section 5 of the Wages Councils Act, 1945, that he intends to make an Order in the terms of the amended Draft Order establishing a Wages Council in respect of workers in the Retail Bookselling and Stationery Trades in Great Britain and their employers.

Copies of the amended Draft Order may be obtained on application in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Labour and National Service, Queen Anne's Chambers, Broadway, London, S.W.1.

Objections to the amended Draft Order must be sent so as to reach the Minister of Labour and National Service at the above address within 40 days from the 23rd day of August, 1947, that is to say, on or before the 2nd day of October, 1947. Every objection so made must be in writing and must state:—

- the specific grounds of objection; and
- the omissions, additions or modifications asked for.
