COUNTY OF YORK, EAST RIDING.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers conferred on him by section 14 of the Water Act, 1945, proposes to make an order defining an area consisting of the county borough of Kingston-upon-Hull, the boroughs of Beverley, Bridlington and Hedon, the urban districts of Driffeld, Filey, Haltemprice, Hornsea, Norton and Withernsea, the rural districts of Beverley, Bridlington, Driffeld, Holderness and Norton, and part of the rural district of Pocklington, as an area in which the provisions of the said section 14 shall apply.

TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be that a new road which he proposes to construct near Asgarby in the County of Lincoln will become a trunk road on the date when the Order comes into force in substitution for a length of approximately 180 yards of the King's Lynn-Sleaford-Newark Trunk Road near Asgarby aforesaid, and the length of the said Trunk Road, superseded thereby will cease
