

WATER ACT, 1945.

COUNTY OF YORK, EAST RIDING.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Health in pursuance of the powers conferred on him by section 14 of the Water Act, 1945, proposes to make an order defining an area consisting of the county borough of Kingston upon Hull, the boroughs of Beverley, Bridlington and Hedon, the urban districts of Driffield, Filey, Haltemprice, Hornsea, Norton and Withernsea, the rural districts of Beverley, Bridlington, Driffield, Holderness and Norton, and part of the rural district of Pocklington, as an area in which the provisions of the said section 14 shall apply.

TRUNK ROAD ACT, 1946.

The Carlisle-Sunderland Trunk Road (West Denton-Newburn Road Junction Improvements) Order, 1947.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport has made an Order under subsection 1 of section 4 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, to construct a road on the route specified in the Schedule to the Order and to stop up entirely the existing junction between the Carlisle-Sunderland Trunk Road and the road leading to Newburn at West Denton.

RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

LONDON TRAFFIC ACT 1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiry of at least 40 days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by section 10 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, as amended by section 63 of the London Passenger Transport Act, 1933, to make the London Traffic (Restriction of Through Traffic) No. 2 Regulations, 1938, (Revocation) Order, 1948.

The Regulation now being revoked prohibited mechanically propelled vehicles from entering that length of Lonsdale Road, Kensington, which was formerly known as Buckingham Terrace and Western Terrace, except for the purpose of proceeding to premises therein or by the express direction of a police constable in uniform.
