RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS, 1930 TO 1947.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 30 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and section 6 of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, and of all other powers, him enabling, to make regulations, to be entitled "The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Regulations, 1948," to amend the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations, 1947, by providing for the deletion from the form of application for a driving licence of those paragraphs which relate to the grant of a licence without test under the provisions of section 2 of the Road Traffic (Driving Licences) Act, 1947.
