*The London—Edinburgh—Thurso Trunk Road (Thrapston—Huntingdon Road Junctions Improvements) Order, 1948*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport has made an Order under subsection 1 of section 4 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, to carry out improvements to the junction between the London—Edinburgh—Thurso Trunk Road and the Thrapston—Huntingdon Road as specified in Part I of the Schedule to the Order, to construct a road on the route specified in Part II of the said Schedule, and to stop up entirely an existing junction

#### MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT

##### TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under Section 4 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be—

(a) To provide for the construction by the Minister of a new road from a point on the Thetford-Brandon Road (B 1107) approximately 50 yards west of its junction with the London-Norwich Trunk Road near Thetford in the County of Norfolk in a general south-easterly direction to a point on the said Trunk Road approximately 20 yards south-west of the said junction;

(b) to provide for the stopping up entirely of the existing junction between the Thetford-Brandon road and the said Trunk Road when the new road has been completed;

(c) that section 4 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1936 (which modifies the Restriction of Ribbon Development Act, 1935, in its application to trunk roads), will apply to the new road on the date when the Order comes into operation;

(d) that the Norfolk County Council will become the highway authority for the new road on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that the new road is opened for through traffic, and the new road will thereupon become a class II road,
