NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF QUESTION BY THE MINISTER
OF NATIONAL INSURANCE.

Guardian's Allowance.

Under Section 41 of the National Insurance Act,
1946, the Minister of National Insurance has sub-
mitted to the National Insurance Advisory Com-
mittee, for consideration and advice, the question
whether, and, if so, in what manner, the conditions
set out in paragraphs (a) and (b) of Section 19 (1)
of the National Insurance Act, 1946, for entitling a
person to Guardian's Allowance in respect of a child
in his family, should be modified by regulations in
relation to cases where the marriage of a child's
parents was terminated by divorce, or the child's
parents or one of them cannot be traced. The
conditions set out in the said Section 19 (1) are
that the parents of the child are dead and one at
least of them was an insured person; the expression
"parent" includes a step-parent

The Committee will take into consideration repre-
sentations from organisations or persons concerned
with this question. Representations should be made
in writing in the first place and should be sent to
the Secretary to the National Insurance Advisory
Committee, 6, Curzon Street, London, W 1, before
6th April, 1948.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

These Regulations contain miscellaneous provisions
of a general character affecting benefits under the
National Insurance Act, 1946, and relate to defini-
tions of "contribution year" and "benefit year"
for the purpose of the Act (regulation 2), the cal-
culation of the yearly average of contributions for
the purposes of widow's benefit and retirement
pension (regulation 3), the basis for the computation
of earnings in relation to benefit (regulation 4), the
circumstances in which a person shall be deemed to
be wholly or mainly maintaining another person
(regulation 5), exceptions from disqualification for re-
ceipt of benefit during periods of [penal servitude,]
imprisonment or detention in legal custody (regula-
tion 6); the suspension of payment of benefit during
imprisonment and such detention (regulation 7);
special provisions relating to the interim payment of
benefits, arrears and repayment of benefit for the
purposes of certain provisions of the National Insur-
ance Act, 1946 (regulation 9).
