

We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter 111, do hereby grant out of our common fund to each of the benefices specified in the schedule hereto in consideration in each case of the benefaction described in the third column of the schedule the capital sum stated opposite to the name of each benefice in the fourth column of the schedule, in respect of which capital sum where so long as the same shall remain in our hands there shall be paid by us to the incumbent for the time being of the benefice the yearly sum stated in the fifth column of the schedule or a proportionate part thereof in respect of the said capital sums so remaining, such yearly sum to begin in each case from the date stated in the sixth column of the schedule

Provided always that this Instrument which has been executed in several parts, one part for each diocese concerned, shall operate only as a single grant in favour of each of the benefices specified in the schedule.
