they are so closely connected with His Majesty's dominions either by ancestry, upbringing or residence, or by reason of national service, that an exception may properly be made in their favour.

4 Candidates must have passed the Final Examination of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors or of the Chartered Institute of Auctioneers and Estate Agents or of the Land Agents' Society or hold a University Degree (e.g. B.Sc. (Estate Management) London or B.A. (Estate Management) Cambridge) which gives exemption from the examinations of any one of these bodies.
