Regulation 1.

At the end of 1 (2) insert.

(3) The series of examinations in the Reconstruction Competition will end in 1948. Candidates who make their first attempt at the last examination held in 1948 will not be allowed a second attempt

(4) A candidate at the first examination held in 1948 who is making her first attempt and who without good cause fails to attend for examination after having been summoned by the Commissioners, will not be allowed to make more than one attempt thereafter under these Regulations

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations deal principally with the circumstances in which persons are excepted from the liability to pay contributions and in which they are either credited with contributions or permitted to pay contributions which they are not otherwise liable to pay (Part II). The Regulations also contain (in Part III) provisions dealing with the disposal, return or recovery of contributions which have either been paid in the wrong class or at the wrong rate (regulation 16) or in error (regulation 17) or have not been paid (regulation 18), and with the disregarding of certain employment (regulation 19)
