East Suffolk Rivers Catchment Area

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives notice that the East Suffolk Rivers Catchment Board, have made application under sub-section (3) of Section 5 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, for the variation of the statutory map of the Catchment Area, so far as relates to the extent of the "main river" as at present defined on the said map, by the addition thereto and deletion therefrom of parts of certain watercourses, as follows:—

STAMP DUTIES.
