DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACTS, 1894 to 1937.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 49 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

An Order, dated 21st June, 1948, authorising the landing for exceptional purposes of an Indian black buck, the regimental mascot of the Royal Warwickshire Regiment, subject to specified conditions.

The Berwyn Mountains Sheep Dipping Order, 1948.

This Order, which comes into operation on 1st July, 1948, makes it illegal to move sheep out of a specified area in the counties of Denbigh, Merioneth and Montgomery between 1st July and 31st October, 1948, unless their movement has been authorised by licence of the Local Authority. Sheep to qualify for a licence to move out of the area must have been double-dipped within the previous 56 days unless they are intended for immediate slaughter. The Order also requires all sheep in the area to be double dipped between 15th July and 31st August and again between 15th September and 31st October, 1948.

AIR MAIL POSTAGE RATES.

(British Commonwealth and Foreign.)

The rates of postage which the Postmaster General has directed to be charged on outgoing air mail packets (other than "Air letters" and Forces letters) posted in the United Kingdom and at British Postal Agencies in Morocco and in the Persian Gulf are as follows:—

I. Civilian Air Mail Packets from U.K.

(i) Letters, 4½d. for the first oz. or part thereof and 3½d. for each additional oz. or part thereof: Postcards 2½d.

Germany, Iceland, Poland.

(ii) Letters, 6d. per ½ oz. or part thereof: Postcards 3d.

Aden, Algeria, Azores, Bahrain, British Somaliland, Cyprus, Cyrenaica, Dubai, Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia (Abyssinia), French Somali Coast, Iran (Persia), Iraq, Kuwait, Lebanon, Morocco (French), Morocco (Spanish) and Tangier, Muscat, Palestine, Rio de Oro, Saudi Arabia, Sharja, Sudan (Anglo-Egyptian) Syria, Transjordan, Tripolitania, Tunisia.

(iii) Letters, 1s. per ½ oz. or part thereof: Postcards 6d.
