MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT

TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 4 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be to re-align and reconstruct Waste Lane, Archer's Hill, in the County of Warwick, from a point approximately 15 yards south-west of its junction with the Weedon—Atherstone—Brownhills Trunk Road to the said junction.

Copies of the draft Order and the plan showing the site of the proposed improvements may be inspected by any person free of charge at all reasonable hours during a period of three months from 28th August, 1948, at the offices of the Ministry of Transport, Berkeley Square House, London, W.1, or at the offices of the Warwickshire County Council, Warwick, or at the offices of the Atherstone Rural District Council, Council Offices, Atherstone, or at the offices of the Divisional Road Engineer, Lombard House, Great Charles Street, Birmingham 3.
