War $f a z m$ ， $\mathfrak{f}$ uty 5 ．The 28th pafts a motion was made in the Affembly at Kolog，far the reading df the Pacta Conucit－ ta，which were to be fworn to by the King，which was op－ pofed fot fome time by the three Brethren Zamaskit who deficed that a caule of chegits migho be firit flateds in tefer rence to an Eftate now in the poferffori bof the Princels of zhet hatne，Mother torthe prefent King，whoclaims its of Inkerting to the late Prince Zamoski，to which the King upon his nomidation was pleafed to ₹chounce all his interent and＇pretenfions，bur the majortry of zoices overbearing them，they fell appon the Arcicles，purting off this caule till the Dies for the Corchation．
In the firf poine relating to the ©economy of the Kings Elate，they made litule progrels；ontly voted the Admini－ Ifration thertef हo be commined so the Noblefs，referting the whole 准据，with phatahout the Batr to the following Diet．
The nextpoinz was，That tle fucteoding Kings yhould notconfert two Cbarges apon one perfon，raluis modet－ nis poffefloribus；which was much preffed by Polobinski， wito pretendedxo the Charge of Gdnetal of Lythuania，now poffeffied by the Duke michacl Raltervih，who is altb－Vice－ Chancellor of the dame plites whict bigan to be dabated with much hedt，she raid Polubinshe being lecondea by the Farting of the Pazi，but the Arch－Bithop of Gnefne and the Bihops interpoling，feemed ise prevail－with therm for the time，that uthis bulinefs fhould be referted to the cifion offame perfors unconer roeds
Tlis ended，they fell upon the debarte iof the allowatite made to King Cafinair of 50 thoufand Crowns，whieth ypho ter fome oppofition was concluded on，and ordered to be duly paid．

The 29．h，the Brethren 2 amoski again demanded that juftice might be done them in their cuufe according to the Kings promife apohthis Nonsination，end xhat they，might betefther prefentily fealed in the esfatocontended for，or have a firme promite thade them of fuctio a fitea fertementis but a great Rain falling，difmiffed the Affembly for that day．
Wn Manday Fuly 1，the Director of the Afrmbly de－ liring to proceed upon the Patia conventas the Breithen Zamoski oppofed tr，plainly fayme，they would coafent to noching，monot the Election of the King，till their caufe was frity detenhinted ；fevetal Speechas wert litreupommade－ with much Oratory，butabe Zamoski perkeiving nothing would be done for ther＇，made a proteltation of the Nul－ lity of any thing that thould pals．and weat oat af the

Afembly：the Diet fell then ro examine the Legaliry of tifis proteflation，which if good woutd diffolve the yig Afrem－s bly，but concluded it faulty，as beings not made in due ime， and a morion was made，that the Z amsski fiou a be decla－
 at taft more inthly y concluded that they fhould be lent to ques－ ly to appeas the next morning at Kojo to revoke their pro－ teflation．
In the mean time，things grew to fome height berwech the Pazti and the bourfe of Raditivit，both partles rally－ ing ap all the force they could，and purting theff in form of batile nesr Kplo，inlompuch as＇was feared they would çharge one anotitit，and with their fiwords diffuce the Gencral－ fltip of y ytbrania，of which the King having infelligences Fent to them，tequiring them to defif foom fobiir violent puy pofes，teft they obiged him to ferid his Ciscular Lerters to the Noblefr of Polind，to proceed againft the as Rebels． to the State，and difurbers of the publick peacem
Whereupon the Paizi finding themfelves much the weaker parry，wete forced to quit their pretenfions，leav－ ing to Dake Michael Radzevill the poffefion of both his Charges，affer which，th Dukes Brother．Duke Bogiflaus was allo declared Grand Marthal of Lyibuania．，Polobinf－ ki thus defeated of his purpofe，the Chancellour Pazzi iaf－ ligned hint the Revenue of two Governments in this：Pro－ vince for two years，towards his heter fubfiffence，and $\mathrm{Ge}_{\mathrm{e}}$ neral Pazti，in lieu of fatisfation of his own pretenfic os， had the Palatinate of Vilian tonfegred on him ：but l．e ligh－ ly refenting what had paft，Terit a ch 1 nge to Duke Rad－ zevil to fight the $\mathrm{h}_{\mathrm{p}} \mathrm{x}$ day Twel\}e to Twelve, which had Sotfart procede ed thar the perfons were named on each par－ sy，all of flidem of Quality and Honou，but the Fing wich the Lords Spiritual interpoling，the Duke Miclaged Radze＝ wil and General Patt wete reconcil＇d before the King， and embrated one another．
Qa Wedaefuay 于uly 3 ．The Zamoski not appearings the Senators and Deputte，from the Palatinates could por pro－ ceed upon their Articles as they incendet，whers घpon feye－ rat of the Afiembly made inveqivcs againft tu mo pletring they might be declared $\mathbf{T}$ ayors and Enemies to their Countreys moving that the french AmbaRadser might be difmift，whom they accured as the Auch． 5 of allthat had paft tot their diffurbance，but at laft broke uppte Affembly for that day without any refolution．
The nexrday they refulved to proceed notwithlanding the proteflation，but agreed not upon any one poinc that day；but the Sieut Polanosh ${ }^{2}$ the Leetrenant－General of Poland having been refuet a Charge，which both the， Arch－Bifhop and the General had defired the King togive him；operly fluwed his difatisfaction，ceclaring his refo－ lution to leave the fervice upon the firf opportunity．
－Gerota，futy io．Thls State being unwilling to enter into a firt ther contef with the Pope in the affair relaing th the Inquifiror＇Geseral，whom for his too great entrench－ ment upon the liberty of this Republick，and 1 Is infolent behaviour in prefence of the Senate，they expelled from their Ciry and Goverr ment，hath Jatcily fent away an cx－ prefs to Rome with a fubmiflive Letere to the Pope，hum－ bly refering th whole bulinefs to his confideration，to make what end he pleares of it．
