Where any person declared to be elected as one of the 20 persons shall have been nominated by one of the bodies in paragraphs 1 to 3 above and shall have accepted such nomination, then the name of such person shall be removed from the list of elected persons and there shall be declared elected that person who obtained the most votes amongst the persons not previously declared elected.

Of the persons elected the term of office of the five who receive the lowest number of votes shall five who receive the lowest number of votes shall be one year only. The term of office of the five who receive the next lowest votes shall be two years only. The term of office of the five who receive the next lowest number of votes shall be three years only. The term of office of the five who receive the highest number of votes shall be four years. Of any of the said persons who may receive an equal number of votes, that one of them whose name was first entered on the Register of Veterinary Surgeons shall be deemed to have received the highest number.
