MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.

TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be that a new road which he proposes to construct at Nant-oeer, near Abergavenny, in the County of Monmouth, will become a trunk road on the date when the Order comes into operation.

MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.

TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be that a new road which he proposes to construct near the premises known as Ysbytty Farm, at Abergavenny, in the County of Monmouth will become a trunk road on the date when the Order comes into operation.
