

COUNTY BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL DEVELOPMENT) ORDER, 1948.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Blackpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order, 1948, made a Direction dated the 15th day of February, 1949, approved by the Minister of Town and Country Planning with modification on the 6th day of May, 1949, directing that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order should not apply to development on land in the County Borough of Blackpool situate on the westerly side of a red line shown on the eight plans annexed to the said Direction and marked respectively "A," "B," "C," "D," "E," "F," "G," and "H" (hereinafter referred to as "the said plans") of the description set out in the Schedule hereto.

The effect of the Direction is that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto cannot be undertaken on the said land unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the said Order.

A copy of the said Direction and of the said plans defining the area to which the Direction relates may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Department of the Town Clerk, Municipal Buildings, Town Hall Street, Blackpool.

SCHEDULE.

The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building or the site or curtilage of a building which has been demolished in consequence of war damage) for any purpose on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year, and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use, being development comprised within paragraph 2 of Class IV referred to in the first Schedule to the said Order as amended by the Town and Country Planning (General Development) Amendment Order, 1949, and not being development comprised within any other Class.
