

(c) that the Council of the County of Lincolnshire (Parts of Lindsey) will become the highway authority for the new road on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that the new road is opened for through traffic.

#### LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.
