Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Dewsbury have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under section 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875 partly to repeal, alter or amend the Dewsbury Improvement Act, 1884 (hereinafter called "the local Act") so as:—

(1) to repeal section 23 (Plans &c. deposited to belong to Corporation) and section 33. (Height of rooms) of the local Act; and

(2) for the several purposes of the application, or for purposes connected with, incidental to or consequent on those purposes, to make any such alteration or amendment of the said local Act or of any other local Act, or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875 and in force in the County Borough as may be necessary or desirable:
