**UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE  
ACT, 1923.**

A Statute made by the University of Cambridge, on the 13th June, 1950, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."
