LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

LONDON PASSENGER TRANSPORT ACT, 1933.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport has made "The London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. 9) Regulations, 1950" (S.I. 1950 No. 1021), coming into operation on the 13th July, 1950, which institute one-way traffic working in London Wall, between its junction with Coleman Street and its junction with Moorgate from west to east, and between its junction with Coleman Street and its junction with Basinghall Street, from east to west.

TRUNK ROADS ACT, 1946.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, the effect of which will be that two new roads which he proposes to construct near Doublebois in the county of Cornwall will become trunk roads on the date when the Order comes into operation in substitution for lengths of the London-Penzance Trunk Road which pass near Doublebois aforesaid and the lengths of the said Trunk Road to be superseded thereby will cease to be trunk roads on the first day of April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Cornwall County Council (who will thereafter become the highway authority responsible for those roads) that the new roads are opened for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Order and the plan showing the routes of the new roads and the lengths of the London-Penzance Trunk Road to be superseded thereby may be inspected by any person free of charge at all reasonable hours during a period from 23rd June, 1950, to 22nd September, 1950, at the Ministry of Transport, Berkeley Square House, London, W.1, or at the offices of the Cornwall County Council, County Hall, Truro, or at the Highways Divisional Office of the Cornwall County Council, Barn Street, Liskeard, or at the offices of the Divisional Road Engineer, Northernhay Gate, Queen Street, Exeter.

Any person may within a period of three months from 23rd June, 1950, object to the making of the Order by notice to the Minister addressed to Berkeley Square House, London, W.1, quoting reference HTR 33/6/02, and stating the grounds of objection.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (Cumberland) (No. 2) Order, 1950" authorising the stopping up of part of the road from Yottenfews to Low Sellafield in the Rural District of Ennerdale in the county of Cumberland and requiring the provision of a highway consisting of a new road repairable by the inhabitants at large, for which the highway authority is to be the Council of the County of Cumberland.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of the 27th day of June, 1950, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
