The King has lately created new Offices of Inspectors General of the Provisions for his Armies; They are to be 6 in number, and to pay him 100000 Livres each for their Places, for which they are to have a constant Salary of 8000 Livres a year, to be increased to 12000 Livres in time of War. The Sieur Palmquist, Envoy from the King of Sweden, is on his Departure for the Hague, being appointed to refide there, in the room of the Baron of Lilliemoot, Ambalfador from that Crown to the States General, who is recalled from that Employment.
