

Land Drainage Act, 1930, making provision for the following matters:—

or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS 1944 AND 1947.

EXTINGUISHMENT OF A PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.

*City of Portsmouth.*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Town and Country Planning, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 23 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1944, as incorporated with the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public right of way over part of a footpath connecting Henrietta Street and Berkeley Street, Portsmouth.

A copy of the draft Order and a map showing the land over which the right of way proposed to be extinguished subsists may be inspected at the City Council Chambers, Portsmouth, during the normal office hours.

Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing, and addressed to the Minister of Town and
